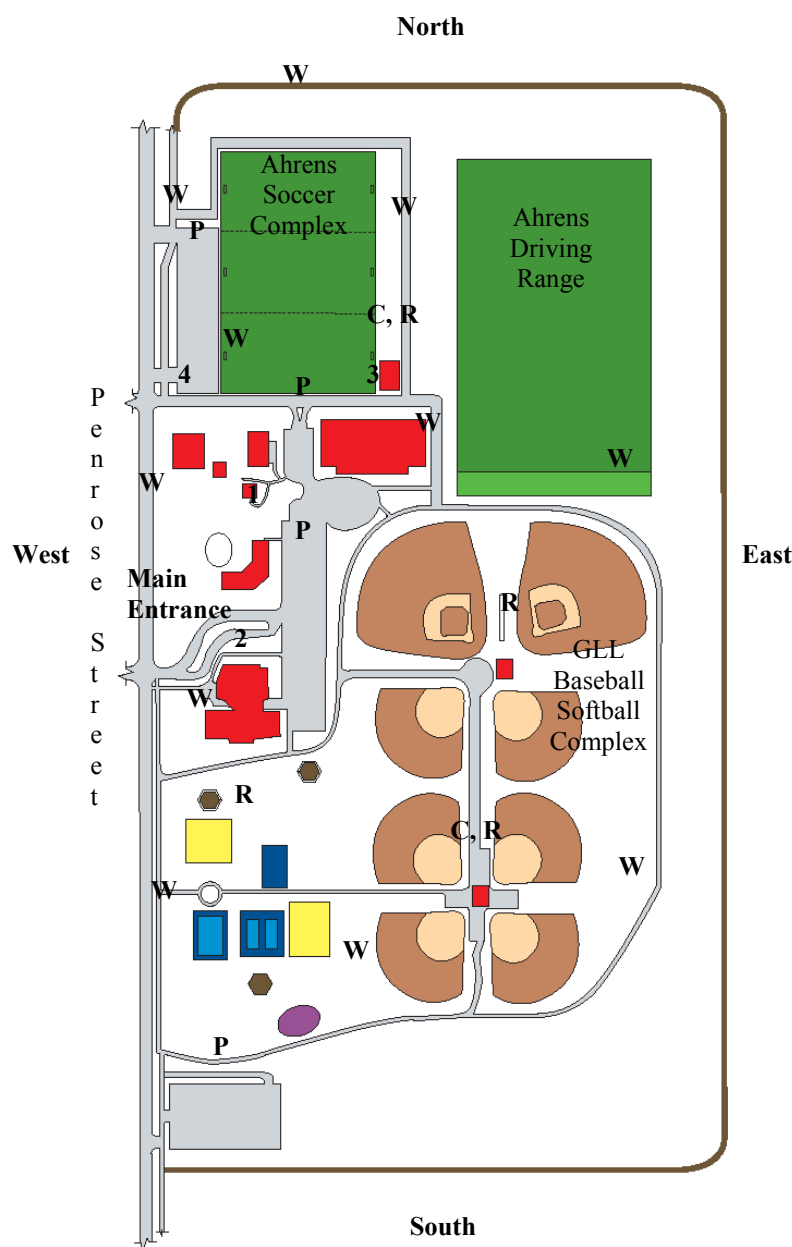




Ahrens/Paschall Memorial Park Map 1500 Penrose Street, Grinnell, IA

Ahrens/Paschall Memorial Park is located on the NE side of Grinnell, just a few blocks north of Highway 6. The park is comprised of over 100 acres of land. Land for the Ahrens/Paschall Memorial Park was originally donated by the late Claude W. Ahrens in 1993. Today, the park is privately owned and maintained by the Ahrens Park Foundation, which is dedicated to providing first class recreational and athletic facilities while partnering with wellness, educational and recreational programs and organizations for the greater good of the community of Grinnell.

- Blue** areas indicate outdoor tennis, basketball, and sand volleyball courts
- Yellow** areas indicate playgrounds
- Purple** area indicates sledding hill
- Dark Brown Hexagons** indicate outdoor shelter areas
